




"New Life Choir Rehearsals Begin (And They'll Be Back In the Loft Soon!!!)


commanded us to "Do this in remembrance of Me". As a reminder, should you need to supply your own bread for health or any other reason, it will be consecrated with the Communion elements.




movie, then share in a brief discussion of the following:
